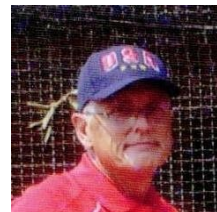

Biography

I graduated from the Community College of Baltimore in June of 1971 with an AA degree in Sales and Marketing. I played in the Valley League for the Madison Blue Jays in 1969. At CCB, I was the Team Captain of the baseball team, received Honors as a member of the Maryland JUCO team, was a member of the All American JUCO team, Vice President of the Athlete Booster Club and was chosen a member of Who's Who Among Junior Colleges. From 1994 to 1997, I coached and owned the Linthicum Flyers travel/select softball team. In 1998, I coached for Carver Arts and Technology School in Towson, MD. I began coaching at North County High School in Ferndale, MD in 1999. During my tenure at NCHS, we have won 4 State titles, 4 Regional titles, 1 County championship and 1 Co-County championship. I was chosen Coach of the Year in 2005 by the Washington Post and the Maryland Gazette. In 2007, I was selected to coach at the University of Maryland College Park for the 10th Annual Old Line Classic All State All Star Softball Game. In 2008, I traveled to Italy for America's Team and had the distinction to play the Italian National Team. Upon returning from Italy, I was employed by America's Team to recruit coaches and players to travel internationally. I am also employed as a Site Director by USSSA and Clinical Instructor for Premier Sports Academy of AACO. One of the highlights of my coaching career came with the opportunity to work with Olympic Super Stars, Jessica Mendoza and Stacey Nuvean.
